## Recent News: Caroline & Michael were selected to compete at the 2025 ISU World Championships in Boston, capping off another winning season!

### GoldenSkate.com (January 26, 2025)

- **U.S. Championships Rhythm Dance:** "Their brilliant and upbeat routine featured level-four twizzles and rotational lift, while the pattern and midline steps were graded a three. The <u>2022 Four Continents Champions</u> scored 82.13 points."
- **U.S. Championships Free Dance:** "The four-time U.S. national medalists displayed very good lines in their exquisite and moving free dance to "Spiegel im Spiegel" and "Dance Me to the End of Love." Their routine included level-four twizzles, lifts and spins, as well as good one-foot and diagonal steps. They placed third with 123.4 points, and with a total score of 205.37."

#### 2025 U.S. Championships:

Caroline Green and Michael Parsons captivated the crowd with a subtle free dance to a medley including Douglas Dave's "Dance with Me to the End of Love," highlighted by a smooth one-foot step sequence and a sweeping curve lift that covered a third of the ice surface. They placed third in the free dance with 123.24 and took the bronze medal with 205.37 total.

"This national championships is the culmination of a huge amount of work that Caroline and I and our entire team have put in," Parsons said. "It was a really hard year last year and this year has been difficult as well. This is confirmation that the work we put in and the dedication we have to ourselves and to each other is paying off." Green and Parsons arrived in Wichita having dealt with injuries and surgery for Parsons in the past year.
